

A Bill to Ban Animal Testing

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** Animal testing on all animals including, but not limited to mice, rats,
3 frogs, dogs, cats, rabbits, hamsters, guinea pigs, monkeys, fish, and birds
4 shall hereby be banned. Animal testing involves pain and suffering, acts
5 as a form of animal cruelty, and promotes unnecessary death and loss of
6 life. Therefore, animal testing shall be banned to prevent the horrific
7 torture the animals are put through.

8 **SECTION 2.** Animal testing is defined as procedures performed on living animals for
9 purposes of research, testing the effectiveness of safety and consumer
10 products such as cosmetics.

11 **SECTION 3.** This United States Department of Agriculture will be responsible for the
12 implementation of this legislation.

13 A. Any researcher or organization that does not follow this legislation
14 and is involved in animal testing will be charged with a fine of \$1
15 million per violation.

16 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect on January 1st, 2024.

17 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
