Global Leaders to Convene at Historic Summit in Geneva on January 4 to Address Israel-Palestine Conflict

In an unprecedented diplomatic move, world leaders including President Biden of the United States, Prime Minister Sunak of the United Kingdom, President Macron of France, Chancellor Scholz of Germany, Prime Minister Netanyahu of Israel, and President Putin of Russia are set to gather in Geneva, Switzerland, on January 3. Their goal: to tackle the long-standing Israel-Palestine conflict and delve into discussions about potential changes to regional borders.

The Biden White House expressed optimism that a comprehensive solution could be reached during the summit. A statement released today emphasized the United States' commitment to a just and lasting resolution, ensuring that all parties are respected in the process. The statement reiterated the U.S. stance on standing with Israel, underlining the importance of regional stability and security for all nations involved.

Following the summit, leaders will hold press conferences to share key outcomes and express their commitment to supporting ongoing diplomatic efforts in the pursuit of a comprehensive and lasting resolution to the Israel-Palestine conflict.
