### Round 1

Other states, including Colorado, Maryland, and Illinois, have passed similar sweeping legislation.

### Round 2:

Google has been under plenty of backlash lately. Earlier in 2024, the company was brought into court over an antitrust lawsuit. Present evidence from the Department of Justice showed that Google was trying to monopolize the search engine competition to gain profit and take control over the tech ad industry. Google was seen enhancing its power through exclusive agreements with ad companies and computer companies, making it the most dominant search engine company. A federal court has already ruled largely in favor of the Department of Justice, but Google is expected to appeal.

Around the same time, Google has also been losing billions of dollars due to the rise in AI. Microsoft Edge had invested in ChatGPT and other AI technologies in their infant stages; now that they've boomed, Edge is rapidly developing and advancing. Google strived to develop its own AI model, Gemini, but has had to refine it multiple times due to errors and biases in its datasets. In comparison, Gemini is still behind ChatGPT and other AI companies in terms of functionality, accessibility, and accuracy.

Most recently, the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) has placed Google's payment division under federal supervision to avoid any fraud or problems. This action has led to a lawsuit from Google's side, claiming that the federal government is overreaching its power and should not interfere with Google's finances. This legal battle is the next step in a series of bruising fights that has left Google weaker than ever.


