# A Bill to Abolish the Department of Education

- 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
- **SECTION 1.** The Department of Education is hereby abolished.
- **SECTION 2.** All former duties of the Department of Education shall be either abandoned or reassigned 4 to other agencies, at the discretion of the President of the United States.
- **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
- **SECTION 4.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

## FP 2 A Bill to Resolve Migration And Strengthen Sustainability in Central America

- 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
- 2. SECTION 1. A. Given the increased effect of climate change on Central
- 3. American countries and emigration out of Central America to the United States
- 4. and other countries, the U.S. will allocate \$200 million dollars from the
- 5. Department of Defense's budget over a period of 3 years to fund climate aid in
- 6. Central American Nations. Another \$50 million dollars will be allocated from
- 7. the Department of Homeland Security.
- 8. B. The United States will form the Central American Sustainability Coalition
- 9. (CASC), which will analyze the effects of climate change on particular Central
- 10. American countries and allocate funding as needed.
- 11. SECTION 2. A. Central American Countries shall be defined as Belize, Costa
- 12. Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua, and Panama.
- 13. B. Climate aid shall be defined as aid to be used only for Climate-Smart
- 14. Agriculture and fixing infrastructure with agriculture.
- 15. C. Climate-Smart Agriculture shall be defined as agricultural practices that:
- 16. 1. Implement drought-resistant crops, advanced irrigation systems, and
- 17. sustainable livestock management.
- 18. 2. Upgrade critical infrastructure, such as flood barriers, renewable energy
- 19. sources, and water management systems, in areas severely impacted by
- 20. climate change.
- 21. 3. Provide training to local farmers and agricultural experts on the
- 22. application of climate-smart techniques, in partnership with Central
- 23. American universities and research centers.
- 24. SECTION 3. The Department of Agriculture and the CASC will oversee the
- 25. implementation and enforcement of this legislation.
- 26. SECTION 4. This legislation will take effect on January 1st, 2027.
- 27. SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null
- 28. and void.

## A Bill to End Pretextual Traffic Stops

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:

- **SECTION 1.** Law enforcement officers throughout the United States and its territories are henceforth 3 prohibited from conducting pretextual traffic stops.
- **SECTION 2.** A pretextual traffic stop is defined as the detainment and investigation of a motorist for an 5 offense that does not present a clear and present danger to those on or near the roadway 6 or which is conducted primarily to pursue suspicion of a more serious crime.
- **SECTION 3.** Any law enforcement agency found to be in violation of this legislation shall lose federal 8 funding until such time as compliance is reached. Any officer found to be in repeated 9 violation of this legislation shall be disciplined up to and including termination.
- **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall be overseen by the Department of Justice.
- **SECTION 5.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.
- **SECTION 6.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

### A Bill to Ban Fluoridation of Public Water

- 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
- **SECTION 1.** The addition of fluoride to public water supplies is hereby banned throughout the United 3 States and its territories.
- **SECTION 2.** Any jurisdiction found in violation of this legislation shall lose all federal funding until 5 compliance is reached.
- **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be overseen by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
- **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall take effect 90 days from the date of passage.
- **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

### A Resolution to Amend the Constitution to Establish the Right to Secede

**RESOLVED,** That the following article is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the United 2 States, which shall be valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when 3 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several states within seven years from 4 the date of its submission by the Congress:

#### 5 ARTICLE —

**SECTION 1**. The right of the people to secede from these United States shall not be infringed.

**SECTION 2**. To secede, the voters of a state must gather a number of signatures equal to three-quarters 8 of the total voter registration of that state at least 90 days prior to the date of the next 9 general election, which shall result in a secession measure appearing on the ballot for that 10 election. If the voters approve the measure with a two-thirds majority, the state in 11 question shall secede from the United States.

**SECTION 3**. The federal government is directed to facilitate any successful secessions and to establish 13 immediate and productive diplomatic relations with the resulting nation, or, should the 14 seceding state join with an existing nation, to maintain diplomatic relations with that 15 nation.

**SECTION 4**. The Congress shall have power to enforce this article by appropriate legislation.

### A Resolution to Celebrate and Protect Surrogacy for Foreign Nationals

- **WHEREAS** A prominent European nation which already bans its citizens from becoming parents 2 through surrogacy has now criminalized the same practice even when pursued abroad; and
- **WHEREAS** This is a clear infringement of basic human rights and a shameless and overreaching attempt 4 to enforce traditionalist and reactionary notions of family that have no place in the 21st 5 century; and
- **WHEREAS** As a global leader, the United States owes it to the international community to reject such 7 hatred and speak up for human rights around the globe; now, therefore be it
- **RESOLVED** by the Congress here assembled that foreign nationals who visit the United States seeking 9 to become parents through surrogacy because they are forbidden from doing so in their 10 homeland are to be celebrated and supported in these pursuits; and be it
- **FURTHER RESOLVED** that Congress encourages all who are involved in such undertakings here in the 12 United States to do their best to serve foreign nationals in a way that shields them to the 13 greatest extent possible from potential recriminations from their home governments; and 14 be it
- **FURTHER RESOLVED** that Congress calls upon all foreign governments not just to decriminalize so-16 called surrogacy tourism but also to legalize and regulate the practice within their borders.
