Broadcasting Material

Round 1 = Breaking News Cold Read

 Cold Read / Breaking News (this will be released in round and students are given a 2 min prep to prepare).

Round 2 = News Program (5 minutes)

- Music Outro / Music Intro = One at each end (20 30 sec each).
 - Students should reference songs & artists from TWO of the following genres = <u>Classic Rock, Country, R&B, or Pop.</u>
- News Stories = <u>ALL news stories must be from the week prior to the day of the tournament (45 sec 1 minute each).</u>
 - Programs should include a wide range of stories.
 Suggestions = local, national, International, sports or weather.
- Commercial = <u>Placed somewhere in the middle of the newscast (45 60 seconds)</u>. Write an advertisement for a film of your choice.
 - Choose a film that is either currently showing in theaters or one that will premiere the weekend of the tournament (Jan 10th).
 - Craft a commercial highlighting the movie's unique selling points (genre, cast, critical acclaim, or special effects). Introduce the movie and include a call to action, such as mentioning a local theater name or ticket options.
- 5 minutes Total Time = <u>With everything combined your newscast should be no more & no less than 5 minutes.</u>

Round 3 = Editorial

- 2 Minute Editorial = Prepare ahead of time and bring to the tournament.
 - Topic = In recent weeks, several major U.S. banks, including Goldman Sachs, Wells Fargo, Citi, Bank of America, and Morgan Stanley, have exited the Net-Zero Banking Alliance (NZBA). This departure has raised concerns among climate advocates about the potential weakening of financial commitments to climate-friendly policies and the financing of fossil fuel companies. The banks cite pressure from political entities and antitrust concerns as reasons for their withdrawal.
 - Question = Should major financial institutions be required to remain committed to climate alliances like the Net-Zero Banking Alliance (NZBA), despite political and economic pressures?

Finals = Combine News / Editorial

• **Final** = 7 minute news AND editorial program combining the material from rounds 2 and 3. This combination may be organized as the broadcaster wishes but must be 7 minutes total in time.
