2024 Chesterton Improv Duo Rules

Thanks for trying improv duo! This is intended to be a very laid-back, low-stress, extra offering for students.

Your judge will provide your topic on a piece of paper and you will have a total of <mark>7 minutes</mark> to use as you wish. You may use any portion of that time for prep and the remainder for performance.

Students are allowed to make eye contact and physical contact throughout the piece.

The aim of improv duo is to work with your partner in creating a believable scene using the prompt given by your judge. Scenes may be humorous, serious, absurd, informational, or anything else as long as it remains appropriate to the environment.

Students are strongly encouraged to avoid the 3 common pitfalls of beginners' improv:

- 1. Sex
- 2. Drugs
- 3. Swearing

Make the more interesting choice.

Following your performance, you are encouraged to watch the remaining duos unless you have a second or third event to run off to. You should not observe until you and your partner have already performed.
