1. Music Choices (Different Genres)

Here's a varied list to expose students to different music styles:

- Pop: "Levitating" by Dua Lipa; "Blinding Lights" by The Weeknd; "Shape of You" by Ed Sheeran
- Rock: "Under Pressure" by Queen & David Bowie; "Don't Stop Believin'" by Journey; "Hotel California" by Eagles
- Hip-Hop/Rap: "Juice" by Lizzo; "Sicko Mode" by Travis Scott; "HUMBLE." by Kendrick Lamar

3. Editorial Question

Rounds -

1 - 5 minute newscast with music in the intro and outro, featuring news picked by the students (we recommend using a mix of international, national, local, weather, sports, or other special interest news), and should include their commercial

2 - 2 minute editorial answering the question above

3 - BREAKING NEWS. Two minutes prep, two minute speech, materials will be provided at the tournament (the ISSDA has an example on their website on what this will look like, we will be following their format)
